

Lady Bulldogs Roll Over Healy

The Lady Bulldogs traveled to Healy for a varsity only game on February 14. The Lady Bulldogs took control of the game and didn't let go as they defeated the Lady Eagles 65-15—their highest scoring game this season.

This game gave the younger girls some much-needed varsity floor experience. “The younger girls played well,” said senior MiKayla Lobato. “They really showed how much talent they have.” Sophomore Maddy Walz led the team in points with 19. Hailee Spresser scored 14 and Jordan Christensen-12. Additional points came from Rachael Ritter-5, Ana Bermudez-4, Kynndra Rush-4, Gabrielle Schiltz-3, Morgan Ritter-2, and Brittany Fringer-2.

“Carmen (Sepulveda) handled the ball well,” added Lobato. “She hustled on the floor and fed off two assists.” Other assists were contributed by Schiltz-3, Bermudez-1, Spresser-5, R. Ritter-7, Walz-1, Christensen-3, and Rush-3. They also played well on defense totaling 12 steals and only had 11 turnovers to the Eagles 30. The Lady Bulldogs outrebounded the Lady Eagles 17-13.

The Lady Bulldogs, who now hold a 13-3 record and are 6-0 in the league, are now ranked #2 in the state on the Kansas Basketball Association. They will return home to play Triplains/Brewster on the 18th and will host the Lady Thunderhawks on the 21st for the last home game of the season. “The remainder of our season should present a number of challenges for the team,” said senior Jordan Christensen, “but I know our girls will rise up to the challenge.”
