

Bulldogs Compete in Quinter

The Golden Plains Bulldogs competed in the Quinter Invitational on May 1. Freshman Clayton Bange scored the only two points for the team finishing 5th in the 3200m run with an improved time of 11:55.57. “The boys continue to work hard and improve,” said Coach Travis Smith.

With eighteen teams competing in this meet, it was a challenge for the boys to place. However, several of them competed well and posted improved results. Freshman Jeron Schutte ran his best time in the 100m at 14.91. He also threw his greatest distance in shot put at 31’ 9.75” and in discus at 81’ 0”. Schutte also competed in the javelin (88’ 7”).

Kade Wessel also posted improved results in the 400m (1:07.48) and triple jump (31’ 7.25”). Kade’s other events were the 4 x 400m relay and the 4 x 800m relay. The rest of the team’s results are listed below.
