

## Lady 'Dogs Place Second in Colby Invitational By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs placed second in the 1A division of the Colby Invitational on May 8 finishing sixth overall in all classes. With numerous girls improving their performances, the girls are looking forward to competing in the league meet on May 15.

Points for the meet came from several girls including Kami Miller who ran her best time of the season at 16.78 in the 100m hurdles for second place. Miller also placed second in the 300m hurdles with a time of 52.01 and first in long jump with a distance of 15' 1".

Fourth place points came from the 4 x 800m relay team run by Gabrielle Schiltz, Maggi Nieman, Kaylie Schaben, and Kynndra Rush with a time of 11:24.71. Schiltz added a fourth place jump in triple jump of 32' 1".

Many girls entered increased times and distance despite the cold and rain including freshman Jennifer Esparza who improved her shot put throw by 14" to 27' 2.5". Results of other events are listed below with improvements marked\*.
