

Bulldogs Finish League with Personal Records By Judy Rogers

Many of the Golden Plains boys finished the Western Kansas Liberty League Track Meet with personal record results. For some, this was a great way to end their season, while others set new goals to achieve at Regionals.

Freshman Francisco Villa has steadily improved throughout the season and his hard work resulted in his best distance of 13' 4" in long jump and a PR of 1:11.21 in the 400m dash. Sophomore Dawson Spresser also set a PR in long jump of 16' 5" and in triple jump of 35' 11.75" for third place.

Sophomore Nick Brown threw a season best 76' 9" in discus and ran his fastest time in the 400m of 1:04.39. Junior Cole Ziegelmeir placed fifth in the 3200m run with a PR of 11:42.93. He also placed fourth in the 1600m run (5:13.12). Freshman Clayton Bange placed sixth in the 3200m (11:43.10).

The relay teams each placed at the league meet. The 4 x 800m team was fourth with a time of 10:03.58 and was run by Jesus Aragon, Devin Carter, Bange, and Ziegelmeier. The 4 x 100m relay run by Aragon, Kade Wessel, Koi Wessel, and Spresser finished third with a time of 54.94. The 4 x 400m team was sixth with a time of 4:23.80 and was run by Aragon, Kade Wessel, Brown, and Spresser.
