

## Lady Bulldogs Place Fourth at League By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs placed fourth at the Western Kansas Liberty League Track Meet in Logan on May 15. Kami Miller had the only league championship for the team. She won the 100m hurdles with a run of 16.89 seconds. She has placed first at six of the seven meets she has run this event in this season.

Several events earned team points in third place. Miller placed third in long jump (15' 2.75"), Gabrielle Schiltz was third in triple jump with a personal record of 33' 0.75", Kynndra Rush set a PR in the 200m dash of 29.46 for third, and Maggi Nieman placed third as she ran the 1600m for the first time at 6:33.23.

Fourth place went to Ana Bermudez in the 1600m (6:59.70) and Kami Miller with a PR of 51.12 in the 300m hurdles. The 4 x 400m relay team of Miller, Rush, Schiltz, and Nieman completed the meet with a fourth place time of 4:51.44.

Schiltz placed fifth in high jump (4' 4") and Kaylie Schaben finished sixth (4' 4"). The 4 x 800m relay team of Nieman, Rush, Bermudez, and Schiltz placed fifth (11:49.98) and Rush placed fifth in the 400m dash (1:07.4).

Several girls finished the season with personal records. They are marked with an \* along with additional results below.
