

Bulldogs Compete in Logan

The Golden Plains Bulldog track team competed at the Logan Invitational on May 5. The high school boys scored 29 points at this meet with several even setting personal bests despite the cold and rainy weather. "We keep improving as a team," said junior Kade Wessel. "Running events have been our strength. We work hard and are improving at each meet."

Freshman Clayton Bange set a personal record in the 3200m run at 11:52.73 placing 4th. Bange also placed 5th in the 1600m run. Two boys set personal records in javelin—junior Koi Wessel threw 112' 6" just missing points in 7th place and freshman Jeron Schutte threw a personal record at 99' 3".

Cole Ziegelmeier, junior, added to the team points with a 4th place finish in the 1600m run (5:23.98) and 5th in the 3200m run (11:58.30). Dawson Spresser, sophomore, placed sixth in triple jump (35' 8").

The relay teams each placed to add points to the overall team score. The 4 x 100m was run by Francisco Villa, Dawson Spresser, Kade Wessel, and Koi Wessel placing 5th with a time of 55.12. The 4 x 400m relay team placed third with a time of 4:21.91 run by Dawson Spresser, Koi Wessel, Kade Wessel, and Nick Brown. Brown, Bange, Devin Carter, and Ziegelmeier teamed up for the 4 x 800m relay for a 2nd place finish at 10:07.29.
