

Lady 'Dogs Place Fifth in Logan

The Lady Bulldogs from Golden Plains posted 57.5 points at the Logan Invitational on May 5 for fifth place at the meet. "It was challenging to compete in the cold and rain," said Kynndra Rush, junior, "but we pushed through and competed well."

Rush ran the 100m for the first time this season and placed 5th with a time of 14.35. She also placed 6th in the 800m at 2:44.57—a personal record this season. As a member of the 4 x 400m relay with Kami Miller, Gabrielle Schiltz, and Maggi Nieman, they placed 4th (4:57.21), and the 4 x 800m relay team of Ana Bermudez, Rush, Nieman, and Kaylie Schaben finished 3rd (11:21.91).

Schaben and Schiltz each placed in high jump—Schaben 4th (4' 6") and Schiltz 5th (4' 2"). Schiltz also placed 6th in the 400m at 1:10.71 and 2nd in triple jump (31' 9.75"). Bermudez placed in both the long distance events including 5th in the 1600m (6:26.15) and 3rd in the 3200m with her season best 14:31.43.

Kami Miller continued to perform well in the hurdle events winning the 100m hurdles with a time of 17.14 and placing 3rd in the 300m hurdles (52.50). She also placed third in long jump tying her season best distance of 15' 3.25".

Charlotte McCurdy improved in two of her events. She improved her 400m time to 1:26.03 and increased her distance to 11' 2.75" in long jump. Carmen Sepulveda increased her distance in shot put to 22' 9.25". Several additional entries just missed out on placing by finishing in 7th or 8th positions. Results are listed below.
