The Golden Plains boys tested themselves at the first track meet of the season on April 10 at the 12-team Greeley County Invitational in Tribune. They scored 8 points and set their base times and distances upon which to improve in the coming season.

The Bulldogs points came from Cole Ziegelmeier who finished fourth in the 3200m run with a time of 12:09.93 and from the 4 x 800m relay team of Jesus Aragon, Ziegelmeier, Nick Brown, and Devin Carter who placed fourth with a time of 10:11.41. Ziegelmeier just missed scoring team points in the 1600m run with a seventh place finish of 5:34.65.
