

## Bulldogs Succumb to St. Francis Pressure

The Golden Plains varsity basketball team struggled in a high-pressure game in St. Francis on January 9 as they fell 28-59 to the Indians.

The Bulldogs only managed six points in each of the first and second quarters while the Indians jumped ahead with 20 in the first and 12 in the second to lead 32-12 at the end of the first half.

Things did not improve for the 'Dogs as the Indians put in another 20 in the third while the 'Dogs added 10—all from freshman AJ Camacho. Another Bulldog six in the fourth finished the game 28-59.
