

Three Pointers Put Bulldogs on Top for the Win By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Bulldogs put in 7 three-pointers in their basketball game at Healy on February 12 to come from behind for the win 76-51. This is the most points the boys have scored as a team this season.

The Eagles from Healy stepped on the floor with determination as they pulled ahead of the Bulldogs 16-9 by the end of the first quarter. The Bulldogs answered in the second by sinking a series of three pointers-five in the quarter- as they scored a record-high 30 points in the quarter gaining a 39-21 lead at half time. "We didn't play our best at first," said junior Brett Gerbitz. "The series of outside shots put us back on top."

The Eagles weren't giving up and both teams added 15 in the third quarter maintaining the Bulldogs' 18 point lead. Both teams worked hard to the final buzzer with the Eagles putting in another 15 in the fourth. The Bulldogs continued their lead adding 22 in the fourth to win the game 76-51.

Freshman AJ Camacho led the team with a season/career high 22 points along with Gerbitz with a season/career high 16. Koi Wessel added 12 points along with 10 from Kade Wessel and 7 from Jesus Aragon. Jeron Schutte, Caleb Korte, Dawson Spresser, and Devin Carter each added a basket. A free throw from Cole Ziegelmeier rounded out the scoring.

The Bulldogs will be back on their home floor as they host Triplains/Brewster on February 16 and Wheatland/Grinnell for their final home game of the season on Friday, February 19.
