

Ringnecks Dominate Bulldogs

The Hill City Ringnecks came to Rexford to take on the Bulldogs on February 9 and dominated the game from start to finish with a 65-25 win over the 'Dogs.

The Ringnecks scored first but three points from AJ Camacho brought the game within 1. The Ringnecks went on a 9 point spree before the 'Dogs could answer. Two baskets from Kade Wessel gave the Ringnecks a 20-7 lead at the end of the first.
