

## Lady Bulldogs Back on Track

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs are back on the winning track after suffering a one-point loss to Cheylin on Tuesday. They easily defeated the Northern Valley Huskies 59-29 on January 22 in Almena.

The girls stepped up to an 18-11 lead in the first quarter. They never looked back as they added another 20 in the second, holding the Huskies to 5. The Bulldogs led the Huskies in both the third (13-6) and fourth (8-7) quarters to win the game.

Kynndra Rush and KayCee Miller each put in 18 points for the Bulldogs. Adding to the win were Maddy Walz-8, Kaylie Schaben-7, Kami Miller-6, and Morgan Ritter-2. The girls worked together with 13 assists—Rush-6, Kami Miller-4, and KayCee Miller-3. They grabbed onto 26 rebounds—Schaben-6, Kami Miller-5, Rush-5, KayCee Miller-4, Walz-4, Ritter-2—and 11 steals by Schaben-3, Rush-3, Kami Miller-2, KayCee Miller-2, and Walz-1.

“I thought we played great,” said KayCee Miller, freshman, who had missed the Cheylin game due to illness. “It was good to be back. We came out ready to play and stayed with it. We ran the floor great, played together, and stayed aggressive.”

The Bulldogs hold a 9-2 overall record and are 5-0 in league play. They will face the Quinter Bulldogs on their home floor on Tuesday before taking Friday off as they prepare for the League Tournament.
