

Lady Bulldogs Down the Coyotes

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs added another win as they defeated the Weskan Coyotes on December 18 in Rexford. This 48-25 win extended their record to 4-1 overall, 2-0 in the league, as they head into the Christmas Break.

The girls opened the game with a free throw from Gabrielle Schiltz. She added two more baskets along with shots from Maddy Walz and Kynndra Rush to lead 9-5 in the first.

The girls extended their lead to 27-10 in the second with multiple shots from KayCee Miller, and additional baskets from Schiltz, Walz, and Rush. Rush added all 8 points for the Bulldogs in the third—hitting 6 of 8 free throw attempts to give the girls a 35-15 lead heading to the fourth.

They added three 3-pointers—one each from KayCee Miller, Schiltz, and Maggi Nieman—as the Coyotes played their best quarter with ten points. The Bulldogs won the game 49-25 with Schiltz credited for 15 points. Rush had 14, ten of which came from the free-throw line as she shot 83% (10 of 12 attempts). KayCee Miller scored 10, Walz-4, Nieman-3, and Kami Miller-2.

The girls pulled down 33 rebounds—Schiltz-11, Rush-6, Kaylie Schaben-6, Walz-4, KayCee Miller-3, Kami Miller-1, Brittany Fringer-1, and Carmen Sepulveda-1. Kami Miller and Rush each dished out 4 assists along with KayCee Miller and Schiltz with 2 each, and Schaben-1. Kami Miller grabbed 5 steals along with Rush-4, KayCee Miller-2, Maggi Nieman-2, Walz-2, Schaben-2, Schiltz-1, and Sepulveda-1.

The girls look to extend their record as they play back-to-back on the road against Triplains/Brewster on January 8 and St. Francis on January 9.
