

JV Boys Battle in Almena

The Golden Plains JV boys battled it out with the Northern Valley Huskies in Almena on January 22 but couldn't come home with a win as the Huskies overpowered them 65-40.

The Huskies pounced early for 23 in the first. The 'Dogs only managed 7 to give the Huskies a big lead early on. The Huskies continued to control the game with an additional 16 in the second. The Bulldogs will play again in the JV Tournament in Rexford where they will compete with Triplains/Brewster and Cheylin.
