

Bulldogs Set PR's at League

The Bulldog Track Team set multiple personal records at the Western Kansas Liberty League Track Meet in Logan on May 13. "The boys continued to improve their times each and every week and I'm very proud of them for that," said Coach Travis Smith.

Senior Vertis Jones turned in several season best times including 25.68 seconds in the 200m dash. The 4 x 100m relay team of Jones, Angel Sanchez, Dawson Spresser, and Dylan Spresser ran a season best 51.43 for 5th place. Jones, Kade Wessel, Sanchez, and Cole Ziegelmeier ran the best 4 x 400m relay of the season for 5th place in 4:10.54.

Dawon Spresser long jumped a personal record of 17' 9" for sixth place. Dylan Spresser placed third with a personal best 37' 5.75" in triple jump. Sem Flores ran the 800m in 2:52.07 for his best time of the season while Cole Ziegelmeier finished third in the 3200m in his season best 11:44.90.

Ziegelmeier placed third in the 1600m run with a time of 5:09.35 and Nick Brown placed 6th with a 2:40.87 run in the 800m. Dawson Spresser, Sanchez, Kade Wessel and Ziegelmeier crossed the finish line 5th in the 4 x 800m relay with a time of 10:30.61.

Jose Ortiz ran the 200m dash in his best time of 31.35. Nolan Ritter threw his greatest distance in discus (100'10") and threw an additional 6 feet for a PR in Javelin of 106' 6". Jeron Schutte also threw a PR in discus of 97' 11". Koi Wessel came up short in 7th place at 49.67 in the 300m hurdles.

Results of other events included Sem Flores-1600m 6:26.86, Angel Sanchez-400m 1:04.91 800m 3:17.19, Nick Brown-400m 1:06.36, Nolan Ritter 400m 1:13.90 Shot Put 31' 6.5", Dylan Spresser-Long Jump 16' 9" 200m 26.75, Jose Ortiz-Long Jump 12' 8" 100m 15.07, Kade Wessel-Discus 82' 8", Koi Wessel-110m Hurdles 21.18 Javelin 104' 4", Vertis Jones-100m 12.71, Jeron Schutte-Javelin 92' 5" Shot Put 35' 4.5" 100m 15.28.

"Cole, Dylan, and Dawson will continue their season at regionals this Friday at Phillipsburg," added Smith. "They will have to perform their best to qualify for State." Field events begin at 1:00 pm.
