

Miller Sets Long Jump School Record

Freshman KayCee Miller set a new school record of 16' 3.25" in long jump at the Regional Track Meet in Phillipsburg on May 20. This jump gave her fourth place and qualified her for the state meet in Wichita.

Miller, a freshman at Golden Plains High School, had tied the record of 16' 2" set by Kristi Withers in 1990 at the Hill City Invitational in April. "After I tied the record, I set the goal to set a new record," said Miller. It felt good to get it and to qualify for state."

"Awesome! Good for her!" said Kristi, who still holds the 200m record in which Miller will be running at the state meet. "I'm glad I still have one standing." Miller hopes to extend her jump to place in the top six in Wichita this weekend.
