

## Bulldogs Play at Home By Judy Rogers

The Bulldogs played their first home basketball game of the season in Rexford on November 19 as they hosted the Logan Trojans.

The B-team boys got off to a rocky start as the Trojans pulled ahead with a 10-0 lead in the first quarter. The 'Dogs found the basket and stepped up their defense in the second with both teams posting up 6 points.
