

GPMS Hosts Scholar's Bowl

On Monday, October 26, Golden Plains Middle School their first Scholar's Bowl of the season in Rexford consisting of 9 surrounding teams. Sixth grade and seventh grade each had 7 rounds, while the eighth grade had 9 rounds.

In the sixth grade, every team competed in 6 rounds and each had a bye round. Heartland Christian took first place with five wins and one loss, second place went to Triplains with four wins and two losses, and Rawlins County finished third with four wins and two losses. Golden Plains ended with three wins and three losses.

Weskan stole first place in the seventh grade side with six wins and only one loss, Rawlins County was second with five wins and two losses, and Golden Plains finished third with five wins and two losses.

The teams in eighth grade each had 8 rounds of competition and one bye round. First place went to Rawlins County with seven wins and one loss. Grinnell placed second with six wins and two losses. With four teams ending with five wins and three losses, there was a tie for third place between Greeley County, Heartland, Brewster, and Golden Plains. Heartland ended up with third place, and Golden Plains finished with fourth.
