Bulldogs Improve at Oakley By Judy Rogers

Although the Bulldogs scored in only two events at the Oakley Invitational Track Meet on April 20, they showed many improvements in their results as the Golden Plains boys have been working hard to increase their distances and decrease their speeds.

Dylan Spresser placed second in triple jump with a distance of 37° 4.5". The relays also did well with the 4 x 100m race placing fifth with a time of 50.71 seconds run by Austin Patmon, Caleb Korte, Austin Rivera, and Nolan Ritter. The 4 x 800m relay placed sixth at 10:21.68 with Joseph Yanez-Perez, Nicolai Schuellner, Christopher Stoltz, and Caleb Korte each running.

Among those showing improvement were Jacob Ritter-100m (13.68) and 200m (27.92), Austin Patmon-200m (25.58), Nicolai Schuellner-800m (2:39.67), Chris Stoltz-1600m (6:11.58), Nolan Ritter-Discus (104'5"), and Austin Rivera-Discus (85'8").
