

Boys Compete in Quinter

The high school boys track team from Golden Plains competed in the Quinter Invitational on Friday, April 28. Although they only scored a few team points, they improved in several events.

Scoring for the Bulldogs were Dylan Spresser with fifth place in Triple Jump at 37' 3" and the 4 x 100m relay team of Austin Rivera, Dylan Spresser, Caleb Korte, and Austin Patmon who finished sixth with a run of 51.13.
