

Bulldogs Compete in League By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains track team competed in the WKLL meet in Logan on May 12 posting several improvements as they worked their way to seventh place with 35 team points.

Placing first for the 'Dogs was Dawson Spresser with a PR jump of 38' 5.5" in triple jump. Dylan Spresser placed second with a 36' 9.5" jump. The Spresser brothers also placed in long jump with PR's set by all three competitors. Dawson finished fourth at 17' 10", Dylan placed fifth at 17' 8.25", and Jacob Ritter jumped 15' 1.25".

Fourth place went to the 4 x 800m relay team of Joseph Yanez, Christ Stoltz, Nicolai Schuellner and Sem Flores who ran their best time of 10:19.97. The 4 x 400m relay team finished in fifth place with a time of 4:17.74 run by Caleb Korte, Nolan Ritter, Dylan Spresser, and Austin Patmon.

Additional points for the Bulldogs came from sixth place finishes by Austin Patmon in the 200m with a PR time of 25.30 and in the 40m at 57.97. The 4 x 100m relay team also placed sixth with a time of 53.50 run by Patmon, Dawson Spresser, Dylan Spresser, and Caleb Korte. Dawson Spresser placed sixth in javelin throwing 120' 7" as did Nolan Ritter in Shot Put throwing 38' 0.25".

Jacob Ritter just missed points in high jump as he jumped 5'1" for seventh place. In the 100m dash, Caleb Korte ran 13.43 and Chris Stoltz set a PR of 13.96. Stoltz ran the 800m in 2:59.39 along with Sem Flores at 3:07.52. Stoltz finished the 1600m. run in 6:14.23 while Flores ran it in 6:33.25.

Joseph Yanez finished the 1600m in 5:48.81 and the 3200m in 12:54.67. "I was improving for the first few meets," said Yanez, "but struggled a bit mid-season. I hope to finish strong at regionals on Friday."

This meet concluded the season for some of the Bulldog athletes while others will continue to work this week to improve their skills in preparation of the Regional meet in Hays on May 19.
