

Bulldogs Compete in Colby

The Golden Plains Bulldog track team competed in the Colby Invitational on May 4. Three boys scored team points in their individual events including Dylan Spresser who placed third in triple jump at 39' 1", Wade Rush placed fourth in discus with a personal record of 124' 5.5", and Harley Weese finished fifth in the 300m hurdles running in 45.17 seconds.

Setting personal records at this competitive meet were Dylan Spresser-200m 25.00 and Miguel Monge-100m 13.79 while others tried new events for the first time this year. Additional results included:

100m—Weese 12.45, Nolan Ritter 13.14, Josh Spresser 13.33, Wade Rush 13.77; 200m—Josh Spresser 27.05, Rojelio Loya 29.17; 400m—Caleb Korte 1:00.22, Loya 1:04.76; 800m—Joseph Yanez-Perez 2:34.81; 1600m—Loya 5:35.89, Yanez-Perez 5:46.43; 3200m Yanez-Perez 12:48.05. "I prefer the mid distance races," said Rojelio Loya. "We are all getting better but still have room to improve."

Shot Put—Korte 38' 5", Ritter 37' 10", Rush 37' 2.5", Miguel Monge 27' 5"; Discus—Monge 106' 6"; Javelin—Rush 126' 1", Ritter 111' 9"; Monge 102' 6"; Long Jump—Josh Spresser 13' 2.75". The Bulldogs will finish their regular season competition at the Western Kansas Liberty League meet in Logan on May 11.
