Boys Score in Oakley By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains High School boys track team scored 30 points in a competitive meet in Oakley on April 19. With 13 teams competing, the finished in the middle at 7th. "Our season is off to a good start," said junior Caleb Korte.

Both relay teams scored with the $4 \times 100 \text{m}$ relay team of Dylan Spresser, Jacob Ritter, Harley Weese, and Austin Patmon placing third with a time of 47.69. The $4 \times 400 \text{m}$ relay team placed fifth with a time of 3:56.80 run by Spresser, Weese, Caleb Korte, and Patmon.

Patmon also placed fourth in the 200m (24.08) and just missed scoring in the 100m with a PR time of 11.96. Weese also set a PR in the 100m at 12.33 and jumped 5'4" in high jump.

Dylan Spresser placed third in Triple Jump with a PR distance of 40' 0.5" and long jumped 17' 9.25". Caleb Korte placed threw the shot for the first time this season and placed fourth with a throw of 39' 11.5". "It felt good to get a good distance my first time this year," added Korte. He ran the 400m in 1:00.65 and ran the 4 x 800m relay with Rojelio Loya, Josh Spresser, and Joseph Yanez in 10:06.71.

Additional points came from field events including Wade Rush who placed fifth in discus (118' 6") and fourth in javelin with a PR of 128' 3". He also threw the shot 37' 11.75". Nolan Ritter placed sixth in shot with a distance of 39' 1.5" and threw the discus a PR of 96' 6" and the javelin 121' 2".

Jacob Ritter placed sixth in high jump at 5'4" and just missed scoring it long jump with a PR of 18' 4.25" and in triple jump with a PR of 35' 7.75".

Josh Spresser ran a PR of 13.50 in the 100m, ran the 200m in 27.47, and finished the 400m in 1:05.24. Miguel Monge ran the 400m for the first time at 1:05.86, threw the discus a PR of 91'4", and threw the javelin 87'7".

Joseph Yanez and Rojelio Loya competed in the distance races including the 800m—Yanez 2:41.20, Loya 2:51.51; the 1600m—Yanez 5:48.09, Loya 6:00.65; and the 3200m—Yanez 12:48.81.

The boys will compete again on Monday, April 23, at the Hill City Invitational.
