Lady 'Dogs Place in Logan By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs scored 73 points for second place at the Logan Invitational Track Meet on May 1. They had two first place finishers including KayCee Miller who set a new school record in long jump at 16' 5.25" and Brooke Stoll who won the 800m run in 2:38.76. Also winning the race was the 4 x 400m relay team of Brooke Stoll, KayCee Miller, Mabel Lugo, and Ashley Stoll who ran a 4:15.96 for their fifth first place win of the season.

The 4 x 100m relay team of Stoll, Miller, Lugo, and Stoll, placed second with a season record time of 52.38. Ashley Stoll also placed second in the 400m with a PR time of 1:01.69 while Miller set a season record of 27.10 in the 200m dash for second place. "Our relays are doing great," said Lugo. "Every time we get closer to breaking the  $4 \times 100$  record."

Candace Taylor ran the 3200m in 17:11.97 for third and set a season record of 7:0979 in the 1600m for fourth. Also placing fourth was Mabel Lugo with a PR of 17.5 in the 100m hurdles and with a season record 1:03.06 in the 400m dash. Sixth place went to Ashley Stoll in the 200m dash at 28.16 seconds.

All three girls running the 100m improved their times including Brooke Stoll 13.91, Karla Hernandez-Lopez 15.96, and Emily Stoltz 15.98. Hernandez-Lopez also improved her time in the 200 to 32.82 and ran the 400m in 1:18.53.

In field events, Stoltz improved her distances in the javelin to 69' 4" and in long jump to 11' 3". Taryn Fleckenstein tied her PR in shot put at 23' 8". Additional field results were Shot Put: Jennifer Esparza 30' 4", Noel Ritter 26' 3.5", Discus: Esparza 73' 2", Ritter 70' 6", Fleckenstein 58' 9", Javelin: Esparza 61' 1", Fleckenstein 55' 11".

"We work really well as a team and as individuals," added Lugo. "We continue to work hard and improve our times." The girls will compete for the second time of the week at the Colby Invitational on May 4.
