The Golden Plains Bulldog track team scored 40 points in the Logan Invitational on May 1. This is the most points the boys have scored so far in a meet this season.

Top scorer for the meet was Harley Weese who placed first in the 300m hurdles with a time of 45.04. "As I develop my technique, my times should continue to improve," said Weese. Also posting points was Dylan Spresser with a second place triple jump of 38' 5.75".

The relay teams had to substitute runners due to injury, but still placed well to contribute to the total score. "The relay teams are working well together," added Weese. "We had some health and injury issues this week, but should continue to place well as players recover."

The 4 x 100m relay placed third with a time of 48.80 run by Nolan Ritter, Caleb Korte, Harley Weese, and Dylan Spresser. The 4 x 400m relay placed fourth with a 4:00.06 run by Korte, Dylan Spresser, Weese, and Miguel Monge. The 4 x 800m relay team of Rojelio Loya, Joseph Yanez, Korte, and Josh Spresser finished third at 10:16.10.

Additional points were scored by Joseph Yanez-Perez in the 3200m with a fourth place time of 13:09.88, by Wade Rush who placed sixth in Shot Put (38' 4") and Nolan Ritter with a sixth place distance in Javelin of 120' 1".

Two players posted up PR results including Josh Spresser 200m-26.61, and Miguel Monge Shot Put 32' 9" and Javelin 107' 7". Results of other events were:
