The Golden Plains High School girls track team travelled to Oakley on April 18, 2019, for their 3rd meet this season. They had 6 girls competing with 16 total entries. They finished 6th of 13 teams with 42 points. "I think we all did well," said sophomore Ashley Stoll. "We dug deep to perform as well as we did despite the weather."

The Bulldogs started their day off with field events. In shot put, Kassie Miller threw 29' 3" and Taryn Fleckenstein threw 22' 2.25" for a season best. In discus, Miller threw a personal best 88' 4", and Fleckenstein threw her personal best of 62' 1.25". In the javelin, Kassie Miller threw 75' 11.50" for a personal best and Taryn Fleckenstein threw 54' 3". Ashley Stoll jumped 13' 5" in long jump.

The girls started out the running events in the 100m dash with Brooke Stoll running a 14.08 followed closely behind with Mabel Lugo 14.29. Ashley Stoll earned points in the 200m dash placing 4th with a time of 29.90 followed by Mabel Lugo in 5th with 29.85.

The GPHS Bulldogs earned big points in the 400m dash with Ashley Stoll, Mabel Lugo, and Brooke Stoll going 1st-3rd. Ashley Stoll won the 400m with a time of 1:04.67, coming in 2nd was Mabel Lugo with a 1:05.94, and Brooke Stoll in 3rd with a 1:06.71. Earning 3rd place in the 800m run was Brooke Stoll with a time of 2:50.02.

Also placing third was the 4x100 team made up of Brooke Stoll, Kassie Miller, Mabel Lugo, and Ashley Stoll with a time of 55.60. "I am hoping to continue our success and get some nice weather for track meets to get PR's!" added Ashley Stoll. The Dogs will continue their track season on April 23 in St. Francis.
