

## GP Girls Take 3rd at St. Francis

The Golden Plains high school varsity girls track team travelled to St. Francis on Tuesday, April 23 where they placed 3rd out of 9 teams with an overall score as a team of 70 points. The girls had many Personal Records (PR) throughout the day.

The 100 meter dash included threr GP girls. Brooke Stoll placed 6th (14.44), Mabel Lugo followed with a time of 14.52, and Taryn Fleckenstein set a PR (16.96). In the 200 meter dash, there were 3 placers for the Bulldogs. KayCee Miller took first (28.49), Ashley Stoll placed 4th (28.92), and Kassie Miller finished 6th (31.17). Ashley Stoll and Mabel Lugo came in first and second in the 400 meter dash. Ashley Stoll took 1st (1:02.63) followed by Mabel Lugo with a PR of 1:05.7.

Brooke Stoll captured the gold in the 800 meter run (2:36.77), a Season Record. Morgan Wark set a PR in the 100 meter hurdles (19.35) and placed 5th. Wark also took 6th in the 300 meter hurdles (58.16). The 4x100 meter relay team of Brooke Stoll, Mabel Lugo, Ashley Stoll, and KayCee Miller placed 2nd with a time of 53.54. The same relay team took first in the 4x400 meter relay and set a season record of 4:17.69. "I think everyone competed well," said Senior KayCee Miller. "It felt great to be back to competition again after two weeks of having to sit out."

The field events included 2 PR's in Shot Put, Kassie Miller (30-06), and Taryn Fleckenstein (24-03). Morgan Wark also competed with a throw of 28-01. Kassie Miller placed 6th in Discus with a PR of 91-11. Wark threw 58-04 and Fleckenstein 54-03. Miller and Fleckenstein both also threw the Javelin. Miller set a PR with 76-03, and Fleckenstein set a season record of 65-08.

The Bulldogs will continue their season on Friday, April 26, in Quinter. The meet will begin at 3:00 P.M.
