The Golden Plains JV girls' track team scored 44 points to place fifth at Wakeeney on April 15. "We did well," said Kassie Miller-freshman. "Several of us set personal records."

Two of the girls claimed first place in their event including Morgan Wark in the 300m hurdles with a time of 58.57 and Kassie Miller in Discus with a PR throw of 85' 7.5".
