Miller Sets Long Jump Record By Judy Rogers

Golden Plains Senior KayCee Miller set a new school record of 17' 0.5" on her first jump of the season at the Colby Invitational on May 3. "I was surprised that I set a new record," said Miller, "especially for my first jump of the year." Miller, who was out for several weeks due to injury was able to jump for the first time of the season. Her jump won the event at Colby.

Miller broke her own record of 17' 0" set at the state track meet in 2018. She had set the record of 16' 4.75, breaking the record set by Kristi Withers in 1990. She then reset the record three times in 2017—16' 5.25 at Logan, 16' 8.25 at Regionals and 17' 0" for first place at state.

Miller will jump again at the league meet on May 9 before attempting to return to state with a jump at Regionals on May 17 in Hill City.
