

Lady 'Dogs Compete in Hill City

The Golden Plains varsity girls' track team competed at the Hill City Invitational on April 15. With only four girls competing, they were able to score 30 points for the Bulldogs in this competitive meet.

Sophomore Ashley Stoll continues to run well as she placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 400m with a time of 1:01.69. Her sister, Brooke, finished right behind her in 3<sup>rd</sup> place at 1:05.24.

Ashley also placed fifth in Long Jump with a distance of 15'0" and 6<sup>th</sup> in the 200m (28.59). "This was my first time to long jump in high school," said Ashley. "I was pleased to have placed." Brooke placed sixth in the 800m with a time of 2:43.65. Both girls ran the 100m with Ashley running a 13.98 and Brooke finishing in 14.18 seconds.

Another pair of sisters competing at Hill City were junior Candace Taylor and freshman Rayna Taylor. The girls placed third and fourth in the 3200m run with Rayna running 16:04.01 and Candace 16:10.76. Rayna placed fifth in the 1600m run at 6:45.38 with Candace finishing in 7:20.40. Rayna also ran the 800m in 3:18.36.

"With just four girls, we competed well," said Rayna Taylor. "Both Candace and I set PR's in the 1600m and 3200m runs." The next meet for the Lady Bulldogs will be on April 18 at the Oakley Invitational.
