

Lady Bulldogs Compete at First Meet By Ashley Stoll

The Golden Plains girls participated in their first varsity track meet of the year at the Triplains Invitational in Colby on April 9. The girls had many placers and took 5th overall with 57 points. "I enjoyed getting to compete in my first meet of the season," said Brooke Stoll, sophomore

Individual placers were Mabel Lugo finishing 6th in the 100 meter dash (14.00), 2nd in the 300 meter hurdles (53.54), 1st in the 4x100 meter relay (52.74) along with KayCee Miller, Brooke Stoll, and Ashley Stoll. The relay team consisting of the same four members also placed first in the 4x400 meter relay (4:20.91).

Brooke Stoll placed 2nd in the 800 meter run with a time of 2:41.91. Ashley Stoll took second in the 400 meter dash (1:02.03) and second in the 200 meter dash (28.05). Morgan Wark placed 6th in the 300 hurdles (58.10). Rayna Taylor took 5th in the 3200 meter run (16:06.56). The 4x800 meter relay team consisting of Candace Taylor, Carli Nieman, Taryn Fleckenstein, and Rayna Taylor placed 6th (14:08.89).
