

MS Girls Score in Hill City

The Golden Plains Middle School girls track team competed in Hill City on April 22. The sixth and seventh grade girls competed together while the eighth grade girls competed separately. "This was a tough meet," said Jordyn Fleckenstein. "It really pushed us competing against the bigger schools, but everyone did well."

The 6th/7th division scored 58 points for fifth place at the meet. Emma Weiner continues to score well as she placed first in the 1600m run (6:17.75) and improved her time in the 3200m to 13:41.84 for second place. Weiner also long jumped 10' 9". Jordyn Fleckenstein won the high jump with a 4' 4" jump and placed third in triple jump with a PR of 28' 5".

Anette Hernandez-Lopez placed second in the 800m run with a PR time of 2:54.36. She long jumped 10' 10". Hayden Wark performed well with a third place finish in the 200m hurdles of 37.80 and a sixth place finish in the 100m hurdles at 20.86.

The 4 x 400m relay team of Hernandez-Lopez, Jaqueline Manriquez, McKinzie Horobik, and Hayden Wark placed sixth with a time of 5:26.62.
