Lady Bulldogs Win Northern Valley Invitational By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs won the Northern Valley Invitational Track Meet in Logan on April 15 with 119 points—just one point ahead of second place Logan. This was the second meet of the season for the middle school girls.

The girls claimed numerous first place finishes to win the meet. Breanna Rath placed first in all four of her events including long jump (14' 11.5"), triple jump (31' 3"), the 100m hurdles (18.07), and the 200m hurdles (34.80). "I was pleased to win all of my events," said Breanna. "My goal is always to set a PR. I am trying to set school records."

Emma Weiner won the 1600m run at 6:16.0 and placed second in the 800m run (2:50.2). She was also a member of the second place 4 x 200m relay along with McHaley Carter, Jazline Manriquez, and Ava Brantley.

The 800 medley relay team of Manriquez, Valentina Bermudez, Carter, and Sidney Taylor won with a time of 2:19.0. A final first place event was won by Jordyn Fleckenstein in high jump with a 4' 4" jump.

Manriquez placed second in the 1600m run (6:25.6) and fourth in the 800m run (3:02.0). Taylor placed third in the 400m dash (1:12.2), and fifth in the 800m run at 3:10.8. Carter finished fourth in both triple jump (26' 10.5") and the 200m hurdles (39.11).

The 4 x 100m relay team of Mia Rogers, Jorja Juenemann, Valeria Ortiz, and Valentina Bermudez placed fifth with a time of 1:28.2. Sixth place points went to Bermudez in shot put (27' 3"), Jordyn Fleckenstein in triple jump (26' 7"), and Ava Brantley in the 400m dash (1:17.1).

"Everyone is doing really good," added Rath. We are all working hard in practice to improve our results." The Lady Bulldogs will compete at the Hill City Invitational on April 22.
