The Golden Plains Middle School girls track team placed second at the Quinter Invitational on April 26 with 83 total points scored. "It was good to place so high at this meet," said Jazline Manriquez, 8th grade. "The girls are all doing well. We hope to continue to improve to win the league meet."

The 4 x 200m relay team of McHaley Carter, Jazline Manriquez, Jordyn Fleckenstein, and Emma Weiner started the scoring with a first place finish of 2:10.61. Also placing first was Breanna Rath with a new personal record of 15' 2" in long jump. Rath also placed first in triple jump with a 31' 5.5" jump.

Several of the girls placed second including Jazline Manriquez with a PR of 13:36.66 in the 3200m run. Rath placed second in the 200m hurdles (35.34) and Jordyn Fleckenstein placed second in high jump at 4' 4".

Third place points went to Emma Weiner in both the 1600m run (6:30.99) and the 3200m run with a PR of 13:37.40. Rath placed third in the 100m hurdles running in 18.90.

Sidney Taylor placed fourth in the 400m dash at 1:14.85 and sixth in the 800m at 4:01.91. The 4 x 400m relay team of Anette Hernandez-Lopez, Hayden Wark, Ava Brantley, and Sidney Taylor placed fourth with a time of 5:13.51. Hayden Wark finished up the scoring in fifth place of the 200m hurdles (38.26).

Among the girls setting personal records were McKinzie Horobik-400m 1:31.49, Hernandez-Lopez 1600m 6:50.08, McHaley Carter-Triple Jump 28' 0.75", and Mia Rogers-Discus 42' 2".
