

MS Boys Compete at League By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team competed in the Western Kansas Liberty League meet in Logan on May 9. There were two divisions-7th grade and 8th grade. Athletes were able to compete in a higher level and many did to help out on relays which were all scored in the 8th grade category. The 7th grade finished the meet with 17 points while the 8th grade division scored 18 with both teams finishing in the middle of the teams.

The 4 x 200m relay team won the event in 2:13.47 run by Owen Patmon, Leighton Munk, Mason Green, and Landon Meier. Landon Meier also placed first in the 1600m run with a time of 2:42.27 and sixth in the 400m dash at 1:09.12.

Owen Patmon placed fifth in the 1600m with an improved time of 6:36.35. He ran the 400m in 1:19.66 and long jumped 11' 5.5". Mason Green set a new PR of 27' 11" in triple jump for fifth place, placed fifth in the 200m hurdles with a PR time of 35.35, and high jumped 4' 6" for fifth. The 4 x 100m relay team also placed fifth with a time of 1:22.13 run by Abe Taylor, Will Bruggeman, Jerri Koerperich, and Dominic Stout.

Leighton Munk set a PR in the 100m of 15.23. He ran the 400m in 1:26.32 and the 800m in 3:19.82. Blake Durham set a PR in the 100m of 19.51, ran the 200m in 44.26, threw the shot put 18' 3.5", and threw the discus 53' 2".

Josh Rath set a PR in 200m hurdles of 40.16, threw the softball 141' 9" for 7th place, long jumped 11' 6", and triple jumped 25' 1". Abe Taylor set a PR in the 1600m run of 7:36.52 and ran the 800m in 3:49.04. Jerri Koerperich set a PR in softball throw of 99' 10", threw the shot 25' 1.75", and threw the discus 55' 5".

Dominic Stout ran the 100m in 18.73 and the 200m in 42.33 while Will Bruggeman threw the shot 21' 0.5", threw the softball 77' 0", and the discus 54' 1". This was the boys' final meet of the season.
