Rath Sets School Record at League By Judy Rogers

Golden Plains Eighth Grader Breanna Rath set a new school record in the 200m hurdles at the WKLL track meet in Logan on May 9. She ran the event in 31.91 seconds to break the record set by Mabel Lugo in 2016.

"I'm so proud of her," said Lugo. "She's been wanting to break it since 6<sup>th</sup> grade. It gave her a goal to push herself harder. I hope she continues to improve in high school." "I had wanted to set the school record ever since I started running hurdles in 7<sup>th</sup> grade," added Rath. "As soon as I looked at my mom, I knew I had done it. In addition to setting a new school record in the 200m hurdles in which she won the league championship, Rath tied the school record in triple jump of 32' 3" set by Valerie Broeckelman in 2002 for the league championship. She also won the league championship in the 100m hurdles at 17.14 seconds and claimed the league championship in long jump at 14' 10.25".
