Wark placed second in 100m hurdles at 20.79 seconds, third in the 200m dash (33.71), and fourth in long jump at 10' 11".

Earning additional points for the 'Dogs were Madilyn Green with sixth place in shot put (21' 0"), and the 4 x 100m relay team of Siena Vargas, Jaqueline Manriquez, Myra Cruz, and McKinzie Horobik who placed second with a time of 1:09.1. The girls will compete again in Hill City on April 22.
