Sixth Grade Girls Place First at Logan By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School sixth grade girls track team set a large number of Personal Records (PR\*) at the Logan Invitational on May 2. The sixth grade competed separately from the  $7^{\text{th}}/8^{\text{th}}$  MS team and scored 81 points for first place.

The girls gained 24 points in the 400m dash with all three girls setting a PR. Anette Hernandez-Lopez placed first (1:15.78), Hayden Wark placed second (1:18.43), and Jaqueline Manriquez finished third (1:19.43). Hernandez-Lopez also placed first in the 800m run (3:03.44) and Manriquez placed third with a PR of 3:16.57.

Hernandez-Lopez placed fourth in long jump at 10' 10.5" and sixth in the 100m dash at 16.02. Wark placed second in the 200m with a PR of 32.64, placed second in long jump with a PR of 11' 11.5", and placed fourth in the 100m hurdles with a PR of 20.65.

The 4 x 100m relay team of Siena Vargas, Madilyn Green, Emma Carter, and McKinzie Horobik placed fourth with a 1:16.19 run. Green placed fifth in Shot Put (20' 2") and sixth in Softball Throw (94' 6"). Carter placed third in Discus with a PR of 55' 11" and sixth in Shot Put at 17' 9.5". Horobik set a PR in Discus of 45' 0" for fifth place and just missed out points in seventh place of the Softball Throw at 93' 2".

Additional results included: 100m—Manriquez 17.22, Vargas\* 19.18; 200m—Myra Cruz\* 37.68, Vargas\* 41.99; 800m—Horobik 3:56.60; Long Jump—Manriquez 8' 5.5"; Softball Throw—Cruz 88' 11", Vargas 53' 5". The girls finished their season at the WKLL meet in Logan on May 9.
