

Bulldogs Place Third at Home Scholar Bowl Meet

The Golden Plains High School Scholar Bowl Team attended their first meet of the season in Rexford on November 4. The Bulldogs went 6-2 in the round robin contests to place third overall.

The Dogs started the day off with wins over Triplains and Rawlins County. They then lost a close one to Weskan but came back with wins over Wallace County, Brewster, Wheatland/Grinnell, and Cheylin. A 30 point loss to Hill City gave them their second loss of the day.
