

Bulldogs PR in Logan

The Golden Plains Bulldog Track Team set several new PR's at the Logan Invitational on May 4 as they scored 41 points and set a new school record.

Junior Ethan Weiner set a new school record of 10:56.28 in the 3200m run breaking his own record set at Quinter just a few days earlier. He placed second in this event. Weiner also set a PR of 5:11.42 in the 1600m run for third place. As a member of the 4 x800m relay team along with Landon Meier, Ethan Shea, and Roberto Loya, they set another PR of 9:15.65 for third place.

Senior Wade Rush claimed the only first place finish for the boys as he set a PR of 133' 8" in Discus for the win. As a member of the 4 x 100m relay team, Rush and team members Shea, Roberto Loya, and Rojelio Loya set a PR of 50.93 just missing out on points in 7th place. Rush also placed fourth in Shot Put (19' 2") and fifth in Javelin (143' 2").

The 4 x 400m relay team of Jovanny Infante, Shea, Roberto Loya, and Fabian Cepeda placed fourth with a 4:13.82 run and Ashton Schiltz placed fifth in Shot Put throwing 38' 1". Roberto Loya placed fifth in the 1600m run (5:27.68) with Landon Meier right behind him in sixth (5:34.34).

Rojelio Loya set a PR of 13.10 in the 100m, Infante set a PR of 27.37 in the 200m, a PR of 1:01.95 in the 400m, and a PR of 16' 11" in Long Jump.

Additional results include: Cepeda-100m 13.20, 400m 1:06.09, and Long Jump 15' 9.5", Rojelio Loya-200m 26.89, Shea-Long Jump 14' 6.75", and Schiltz-Discus 86' 3" and Javelin 86' 11". The boys will compete at the Colby Invitational on May 7.
