

Lady Bulldogs Win Quinter Invitational

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs won first place at the Quinter Invitational on April 30 with a total of 89 points scored.

Freshman Emma Weiner set another school record in the 1600m setting her own record for the third time this season. She ran a 5:39.75 for first place. She also placed first in the 3200m run at 12:09.09.

Two of the Bulldogs relay teams claimed first to add to their total points. The 4 x 800m relay team of Ashley Stoll, Brooke Stoll, Rayna Taylor, and Emma Weiner ran a 10:41.09 for first while the 4 x 400m relay team placed first with a time of 4:30.11 run by B. Stoll, A. Stoll, Weiner, and Sidney Taylor.

Sophomore Breanna Rath added second place points in both the Triple Jump (32' 3") and the 100m hurdles (18.54). Ashley Stoll placed second in the 400m with a season best run of 1:04.32 and Brooke Stoll placed second in the 800m run (2:40.25).

Finishing in third place was Rath in Long Jump at 15' 6". Fourth place was awarded to Morgan Wark in the 100m hurdles (19.07) and the 4 x 100m relay team of Brooke Stoll, Sidney Taylor, Breanna Rath, and Ashley Stoll (54.94). Sidney Taylor also placed fifth in the 400m at 1:08.40 while Kassie Miller threw 31' 9" in shot put for sixth. Miller threw the discus a PR of 101' 7.5" just missing points in 7th place and set a PR in Javelin at 89' 8". Wark also set a PR in Discus of 88' 10".
