

JV Competes in Goodland By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains JV Track team competed in the only JV meet of the season in Goodland on May 3. The boys team, with just 4 competitors, scored 11 points while the girls, with just 4 participants, posted 14 points.

Ava Brantley placed second in the 400m with a time of 26' 0" and set a new PR in the 200m of 32.07 just missing points in 7th place. She ran the 100m in 15.28 seconds.

Valentina Bermudez set a PR in both the Shot Put of 26' 0" for 4th and in the Discus placing 6th at 63' 10". She also threw the javelin 60' 7.75". "It was good to get more experience," said Bermudez. "This meet was more competitive for some of us. It was nice to set PR's as we are constantly improving."

Jorja Juenemann set a PR of 17' 11.5" in shot put and a PR of 39' 4" in Discus. She threw the Javelin 31' 1.5". Valeria Ortiz also set a PR of 17' 3.5" in Shot Put and threw the Discus 44' 2" and the Javelin 31' 9.25".

Landon Meier placed 2nd in the 1600m run with a new PR of 5:33.63. "I was glad to set a PR despite the windy weather," said Meier. He ran the 800m in 2:49.35 and was a member of the fifth place 4 x 400m relay team along with Will Bruggeman, Jerrit Koerperich, and BJ Rogers with a time of 1:05.6

In the Shot Put, Koerperich set a PR of 28' 9". "I will continue to work on my form to keep improvng," added Koerperich. Rogers threw the shot 23' 9.5" and Bruggeman threw 24' 1". Results of Discus were Koerperich 86' 3", Bruggeman 75' 11", Rogers 71' 1". Javelin throws were Koerperich 69' 9.5", Rogers 50' 9", Bruggeman 56' 6". The track team will compete again in Logan on May 4.
