

Bulldogs Drop Game to Huskies

The Golden Plains Bulldog basketball team dropped a game 42-84 to the Northern Valley Huskies in Almena on February 16.

Sophomore Dylan Wark opened the game with a 3-2 lead for the Bulldogs but the Huskies took over and led 24-9 by the end of the first. The Dogs only added 4 points from Miguel Garcia in the second as the Huskies pulled ahead 50-13 at the half.

With help from the “crazy athleticism of Diego Perez” and with Garcia as a “bright spot on defense” as reported by the Open Spaces Sports broadcaster, the Dogs pumped in 20 points in the third quarter. The Huskies still extended their lead by an additional 24 for a 74-33 lead going into the fourth.

The Dogs put up 9 more to finish the game along with 10 from the Huskies giving them the 84-42 win. Dylan Wark led the Bulldogs with 21 points. Owen Patmon added 8, Miguel Garcia 7, Josh Rath 3, and Abe Taylor 2.

Rath and Wark each had 5 rebounds and 1 assist, and 1 steal. Perez and Garcia had 3 rebounds each, Zeke Weiner 2, Jose Rios 1, and Owen Patmon 1. Garcia also had an assist. Weiner and Perez each had 2 steals and Patmon 1. The Bulldogs finished their regular season against Wallace County in Sharon Springs on February 20.
