Steals were snatched by Wark 3, Patmon 3, Rath 2, Perez 2, Garcia 1, and Taylor 1.

"We've had a pretty good season so far," added Patmon. "We've improved a lot from last year and continue to improve as we move into the post season." The Dogs played again on February 16 as they traveled to Almena to face the Northern Valley Huskies.
