Garcia had 5 rebounds and 1 steal. Perez had 4 rebounds, 1 steal, and 1 block. Patmon had 2 rebounds and 2 assists. Taylor had 3 rebounds and Zeke Weiner had 1 rebound and 1 assist. The boys return to the court on January 2 when they host Wichita County.
