Bulldogs Fall to Wichita County By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Bulldog basketball team opened their 2024 season with a 27-62 loss to the Wichita County Indians in Rexford on January 2. "It was pretty rough," said sophomore Dylan Wark, who led the Bulldogs with 14 points. "They were pretty big."
