

Bulldogs Named to All-League Team

Two Golden Plains High School basketball team members have been named to the Western Kansas Liberty All-League Basketball teams. Senior Jordyn Fleckenstein was named first team all league and sophomore Dylan Wark was named second team all-league.

Fleckenstein finished the season with 241 points for the Lady Bulldogs. She also had 144 rebounds, 40 assists, and 32 steals. She was named as a scoring leader by Sports in Kansas throughout the year.
