Bulldogs Compete in Colby By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Bulldogs track team competed in the Colby Invitational on May 9. The boys showed improvements as several placed in their events to lead the team to a 5<sup>th</sup> place finish in the Class IA division.

Senior Tristan Schwarz finished in 1<sup>st</sup> place in discus (139'4.5"), 2<sup>nd</sup> place in shot put with a personal best throw of 47' 9.75", and was a member of the 5<sup>th</sup> place 4 x 100m relay team (46.54) along with team members Zach Spresser, Grant Spresser, and Josh Barnhart with their best run of the season. Zach Spresser also scored points for the Bulldogs by placing 2<sup>nd</sup> in triple jump (41' 4"), and 3<sup>rd</sup> in long jump (19' 2.25"). The final Bulldog point scored came from Cole Ziegelmeier in the 3200m run (11:45.89-6<sup>th</sup>).

Several boys just missed points but posted up personal bests for the season including Grant Spresser-long jump 18' 1.5", Dawson Spresser-long jump 16' 1.5", and Kade Wessel-javelin 83' 5".
