Rounding out the scoring was the 4 x 400m relay team of Nick Brown, Dawson Spresser, Kade Wessel, and Koi Wessel running the event in 4:38.36 for fifth place. Other boys improving their performances were Jacob Antholz-discus 108'9" and Nick Brown-800m 2:37.73 and 1600m 5:52.64.
