

Lady Bulldogs Defeat the Cheylin Cougars By Jordyn Fleckenstein

The Lady Bulldogs defeated the Cheylin Lady Cougars 55-14 on January 29 at home. This was the first time of the season these two teams have matched up allowing the Dogs to continue their season record of 11-0.
